Training Service Provision:

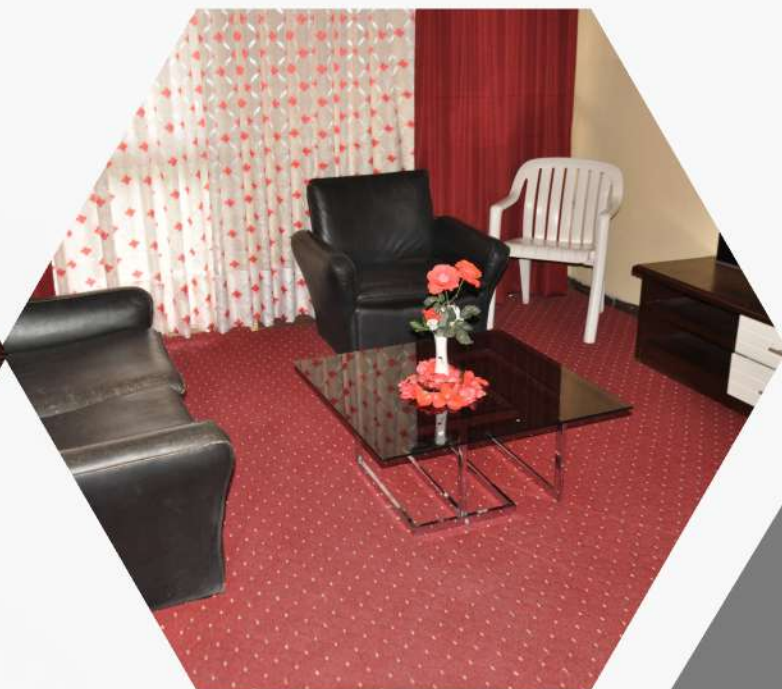
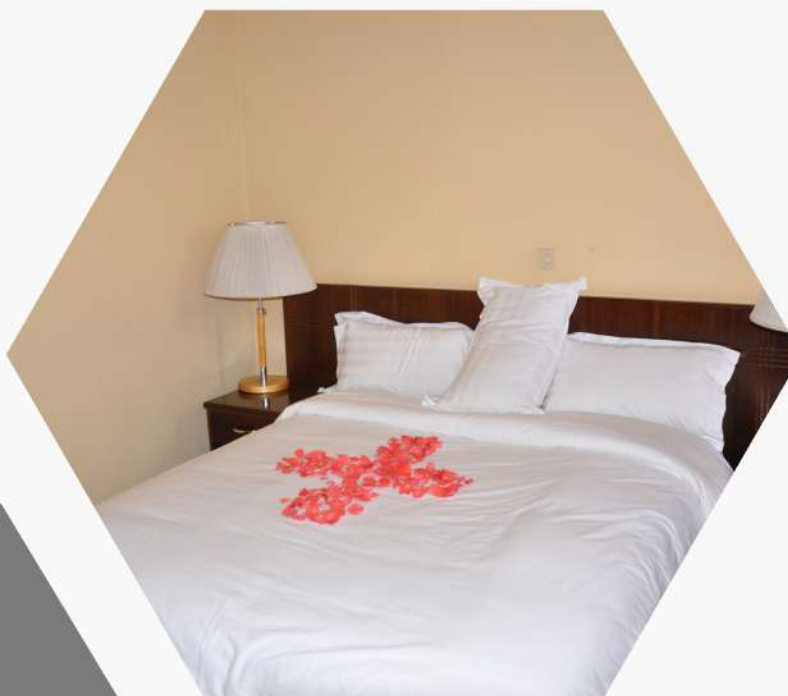
Conducting training need assessments, developing training designs, developing training manuals and delivering trainings as per the need of customers.
